The scholarship is dedicated to the memory of former Commander Kenneth Fritsche Sr., and former Quartermaster Manfred H. Rorig, of VFW Post 9024.

The applicant should be in the upper 40% of the senior class at the end of the first semester of their senior year, as verified by your counselor. The scholarship will be for one year in the amount of \$1000. The applicant must be a graduating senior who is a resident of Woodbury. The grant will be paid directly to and administered by the college, university or vocational technical institute. Schools must be accredited for the curriculum in which the applicant is enrolled. The scholarship will be paid at the beginning of the student's first semester.

Applications must be submitted through your counselor and the guidance office at your school, who will forward the applications to the Woodbury VFW Post 9024 scholarship committee. The top 6 applicants will be contacted via phone to be interviewed. The deadline for applications is April 28, 2017.
